
Here Comes Ice Cream

Nothing says summer like the tinkling tunes of the neighborhood ice cream truck, instantly making mouths water for a frozen treat. Ice cream vendors have been peddling cold concoctions on city streets since the 1800s, announcing their presence with bells, harmonicas, barrel organs or their own singing voices. In the 1920s, motorized trucks began to replace pushcarts and wagons, but drivers still relied on bells to advertise their frosty offerings. Weary of manually clanging the bells all day, some vendors strapped music boxes to their vehicles, blasting out folk songs such as "Turkey in the Straw," "The Entertainer" and "Pop Goes the Weasel."

The music was a marketing success, creating a need for electronic music boxes made for ice cream trucks. As the industry took off in the 1950s, data showed that trucks with music boxes sold twice as much ice cream as those with bells.

Nowadays, ice cream trucks continue to crank out old-fashioned tunes, enticing customers with nostalgia and, of course, tasty treats.
