Health Check

'Tis the season again, <u>flu season</u>. Did you know that adults aged 65 and older account for the highest rates of influenza related hospitalizations, complications, and mortalities? In the 2023-2024 flu season of 27,965 deaths, 19,038 were among those 65 and older. Proper hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette reduce transmission. Annual influenza vaccinations are always the first line of defense and recommended. Depending on a person's age, a higher dose may be required. Remember if you're not feeling well, it is essential to not visit those in healthcare settings. To locate nearby flu shot providers, use the CDC Vaccine Finder tool.
